


Drainage Solutions



Water can enter the brick at any point around the structure. The method of repair drawn above is a proven method of repair to prevent water intrusion at the point where the concrete wall and the stud wall starts. This method is a simple repair that prevents excavating the entire structure to locate the area in which water is entering the brick. Once the water gets behind the brick it has no relief point; the water will follow the brick ledge until it reaches the stud wall, the point of least resistance. Chiseling the brick will allow a relief point before the water reaches the stud wall.
